*Discipline Resulting from an Accumulation of Demerits. (Based on the Student Handbook of Eucon International School)*

1. Upon receiving ten demerits, the student will serve two consecutive detention halls. For every five demerits received thereafter, the student will serve one detention hall.
2. Upon receiving twenty demerits, the student is required to report to the administrator's office for a spanking. At any time a teacher deems it necessary, the student can be sent to the office for spanking regardless of the number of demerits, but upon twenty, he will definitely be sent (See Corporal Punishment, page 45 of Student Handbook).
3. Upon fifty, the student will serve an "in-house suspension" and the parents of the student will be notified and will need to make an appointment.
4. Upon seventy-five, the parents will once again be notified, and the student will lose all school privileges for a period of three weeks. This includes both social and extra-curricular activities.
5. Upon one hundred, the student is suspended from school for three days. This three days suspension is an unexcused absence and carries with it zeros for every item of class work missed. This suspension is also entered on the student's permanent record.
6. Upon one hundred twenty-five, the student is EXPELLED from school for the remainder of the year.

## **Hair Cut Policy**

Part of EUCON's dress code is hair style. The men are required to have neat, trimmed haircuts. From the Student Handbook, the guidelines for boys' hair are as follows: "Boys' hair may not touch the collar and must be neatly trimmed in the back (blocked or tapered). It must not touch the ears and must be tapered about them. Bangs must not hang down into the eyes, but must be at least one and one half inches above the eyebrows. Sideburns are to be no longer than the top of the ear lob. Boys are not to have 'rat tails', 'surfer' cuts, wigs, bleached or dyed hair, 'punk', or faddish hair styles."

To help ensure that these guidelines are followed, a hair check will take place during Chapel every week, which is usually on a Thursday. If at that time a boy's hair does not meet the school's guidelines a barber will be called and a hair cut administered so that the hair will meet the standard. A \$5 fee will be charged for the hair cut.

As the guardian, I agree to the hair guidelines set by EUCON. I realize that my student must regularly get haircuts in order to maintain a clean, trimmed style. Therefore, if my student's hair does not follow the guidelines clearly stated here and in the Handbook, I give EUCON permission to cut my student's hair.
